Slated to open in September 2011, the Professional Teaching Kitchen at Carpinteria High School will benefit local students as well as the entire Carpinteria community. Over \$1.1 million has already been raised to support the facility including a \$435,000 grant from the California Department of Education. Construction will commence after reaching a \$1.5 million funding goal.
