SAT Program

This comprehensive course covers Math, Critical Reading, and Writing for the SAT. We will cover general SAT test strategies while providing detailed instruction on all of the specific question types found in Math, Critical Reading, and Writing. Two full-length practice tests will be administered on two Fridays (7/10 & 7/24) from 10:00am-1:00pm. Detailed score reports for these tests will be provided for each student. The course fee includes all books and materials. (Maximum- 12 students) \$499

ACT Program

This comprehensive course consists of Math, Science, English, and Reading sessions. We will cover general ACT test strategies while providing detailed instruction on all of the specific question types found in Math, English, Reading, and Science. Two full-length practice tests will be administered on two Fridays (7/03 & 7/17) from 10:00am-1:00pm. Detailed score reports for these tests will be provided for each student. The course fee includes all books and materials. (Maximum- 12 students) \$499

PSAT Program

This comprehensive course covers Math, Critical Reading, and Writing for the PSAT. The PSAT serves two main purposes: to help practice for the Scholastic Achievement Test (SAT), an exam many schools require as part of their admissions processes, and to qualify high scoring students for the prestigious National Merit Scholarship program. The course will review concepts and learn proven test-taking techniques to improve your PSAT score. Two full-length practice tests will be administered on two Fridays (7/10 & 7/24) from 1:00pm-4:00pm. Detailed score reports for these tests will be provided for each student. The course fee includes all books and materials. (Maximum- 12 students) \$299

Essay Writing

This course will work with a small group of students to improve their writing skills for essays similar to those they will see on the SAT, ACT, and college admissions applications. The course will focus on the development, organization, and sentence structure of each student's essay. We will also work on the use of language/vocabulary and demonstrating a command of grammar and usage. Class size will be kept small for individualized attention. (Maximum- 5 students) \$299
